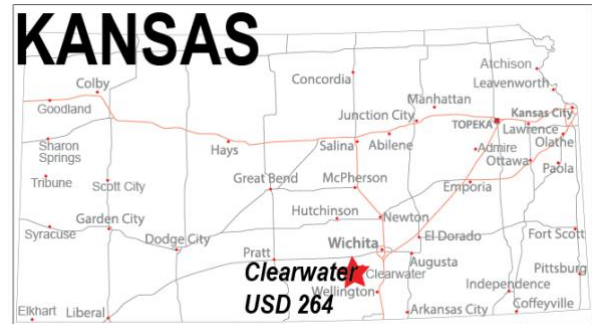

- The Clearwater School District serves a community with a population of approximately 5,000. The [City of Clearwater](#) is located 15 miles southwest of Wichita and has a population of 2,500.
