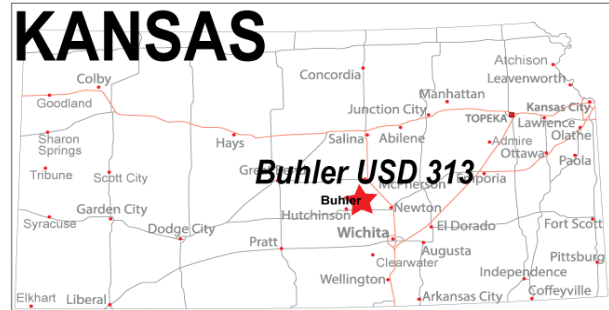

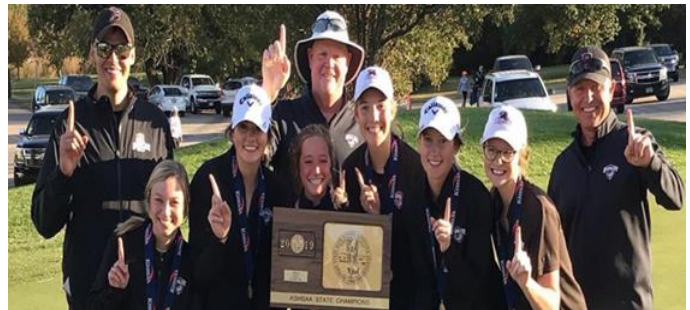
OUR SCHOOL COMMUNITY

The greater school community of Buhler USD 313 includes the city of Buhler, a portion of suburban Hutchinson, residential tracts and rural farms. Located in the northeast part of Reno County and western Harvey County in south-central Kansas, Buhler USD 313 encompasses 144 square miles, and has a total population exceeding 15,000.
