## OUR SCHOOL COMMUNITY

Encompassing 36 square miles of south-central Sedgwick County, the Haysville School District draws students from a wide range of urban and rural backgrounds to create a rich, well-blended student body. Our curriculum, designed to meet each student's educational needs, emphasizes the core academic areas of reading, math, science, and social studies, while incorporating all State of Kansas standards for education and reflecting national curriculum reform efforts. Our schools offer a safe learning environment with excellent teachers and staff focused on the success of their students. To meet the unique needs of each learner, the academic progress of students is monitored for early intervention. The population of Haysville is 11,489.

With direct access to the Kansas Turnpike at 71st Street South, Haysville residents can be in the heart of Wichita within 15 minutes. Alternately, they can choose to drive into Wichita via U.S. 81 or I-135. All routes are fast and convenient, putting opportunities for additional education, entertainment, and jobs within easy reach. Haysville residents can reach Wichita Dwight D. Eisenhower National Airport in 20 minutes and McConnell Air Force Base in 10 minutes.

In 2015 the patrons of Haysville USD 261 voted to approve a \$59 million dollar bond project to "Keep Kids Safe". Safe rooms were built in all of our schools, a new school building housing Haysville High School and Tri-City Day School was constructed, a new pool/natatorium was built at Campus High School and improvements were made to current buildings.
