Golden Plains School District is located in Northwest Kansas consisting of 242 square miles. The district's students come from the communities of Rexford, Selden, Menlo, Gem, Dresden, and Jennings. These communities are in four counties, Thomas, Sheridan, Decatur, and Rawlins. Golden Plains' students receive a quality education; pride themselves on the academic accomplishments as well as their success in multiple interscholastic activities. Golden Plains is noted for its grass-roots leadership in providing each student with a quality education. Each student, staff member, family and community member in the Golden Plains School District is a valued member of our nurturing educational system.

Golden Plains consist of two attendance centers. PK-5th grades are in Selden and $6-12^{th}$ grades are in Rexford, approximately 10 miles west of Selden. The district office is in the Elementary building.

Golden Plains has a dedicated staff that continually strives to provide an education to meet the needs of each individual student. The District's English as a Second language program and Migrant Education program as well as implementation of MTSS process at the Elementary School, are several examples of this commitment. In an era of declining enrollment, Golden Plains is proud of the fact that our full-time equivalency has remained relatively steady for the past several years. Through grant monies, donations and savings, Golden Plains has updated the elementary school facility to enhance energy efficiency and provide a more comfortable learning environment for our students. One great accomplishment is a new daycare facility that Golden Plains has started effective August, 2020
