OUR SCHOOL COMMUNITY

USD 327 includes the communities of Ellsworth, Kanopolis and Geneseo and are in Ellsworth and Rice Counties. USD 327 is near the middle of the state with access to many major highways, is located between two recreational lakes, and encompasses 425 square miles.

Of the three attendance centers, the middle school facility is in Kanopolis, while the Elementary and Jr/Sr high school are in Ellsworth. USD 327 is home to the Ellsworth Bearcats! It is a small 3A school and a member of the NCAA league.

Ellsworth is a progressive and thriving small community of approximately 2,900. Medical services include a hospital with a wellness center, clinic, and a long-term care facility. The hospital has seven full time doctors/PAs with additional quality staff and specialists that come weekly/monthly.

Patrons are involved in farming, agricultural businesses, and several small businesses including financial establishments, a grocery store, insurance agencies, pharmacies, restaurants, and a state prison offering multiple opportunities for employment. Three of our businesses have international clients.

Ellsworth/Kanopolis area offers multiple recreational opportunities including a swimming pool, Frisbee golf course, Youth Recreational sports, 18-hole golf course, Fort Harker Museum, a drive-in theatre, and a recently added Splash Pad, all in addition to the two state lakes within a 30-mile distance.
