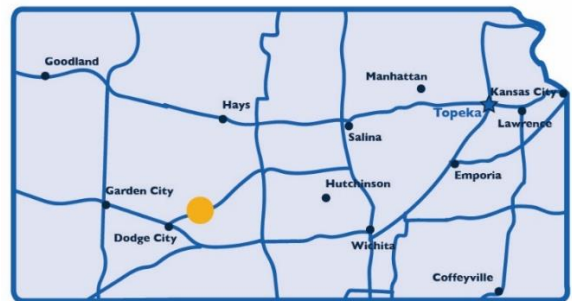

DISTRICT HIGHLIGHTS

The towns of Kinsley and Offerle are located eight miles apart on Highway 50-56. Students in grades 6-12 attend classes in Kinsley. Students in grades K-5 attend the elementary school in Offerle. Preschool is presently located in Kinsley. We are a Class 1A school and a member of the Central Prairie League. The district covers 325 square miles.

Kinsley-Offerle is the home of the COYOTES. The district has had a 1:1 iPad program for grades Pre-K - 12 for the past 9 years.

Extracurricular activities offered are band, basketball, football, track, vocal music, volleyball, and shooting sports club as well as several student organizations such as Forensics, KAYS, National Honor Society, and Scholar's Bowl. We are a member of the Tri-County Special Education Cooperative.

Edwards County is located in the southwest region of the State of Kansas. Kinsley is the largest town and serves as the county seat. Kinsley is 1,561 miles from New York and San Francisco giving it the designation of "Midway USA". The Edwards County Historical Museum and Sod House, along with the "Midway USA" sign and park are a hidden treasure as the museum is one of the most comprehensive in the Southwest.
