The Sublette School system was established in 1913. The Middle School's construction was completed in 1990 and in 2004 there was a major expansion and remodel of the High School and Grade School. 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OUR COMMUNITY

Sublette was founded in 1912. It was named for William Lewis Sublette, a French Huguenot who was a partner in the Rocky Mountain Fur Company. Sublette is in the Southwest Corner of the state, approximately 40 miles North of the Oklahoma border and 50 miles East of the Colorado border. It is centrally located between three larger cities: Garden City 35 miles North, Liberal 30 miles South and Dodge City 50 miles East. Land area per square mile is 577.52 with 7.4 persons per square mile.

Sublette is the County Seat with a county population around 4,300 and the city population of about 1,425. The demographic makeup of Sublette is about 68% Caucasian and 28% Hispanic; 33% of homes speak another language other than English. The home ownership in Sublette rates about 74% with 2.96 persons per household.
