OUR SCHOOL COMMUNITY

Wheatland USD 292 located in Grainfield along I-70 in Northwest Kansas serves the communities of Grainfield, Gove and Park, and is midway between Denver and Kansas City. This middle district of Gove County is 437 square miles, and one hour from Colby or Hays.

Wheatland Elementary School serves children ages PreK through 4th grade. Wheatland High School sits along I-70 on Highway 23 and serves 9th through 12th grade students.

USD 292 is in a partnership with USD 291 Grinnell through an academic cooperative agreement. A football and crosscountry cooperative that began in the late 1990's extended into a sports cooperative for volleyball, basketball, and track cooperative in 2006. It became a full cooperative agreement for academics in 2007 as students who play together should learn together. As part of this current agreement, all students in grades 5-8 attend Grinnell Middle School and all student grades 9-12 attend Wheatland High School. Under the cooperative, 53 students attend WHS, and 35 students attend Grinnell Middle School.
