OUR SCHOOL COMMUNITY

USD 341 provides a PreK-12 school program for central Jefferson County, KS, in Northeast Kansas. The district is organized into a PreK-6th Grade Elementary School and a 7-12 JR/SR High School. The city of Oskaloosa has a population of approximately 1,100 and is the county seat.

Oskaloosa is currently classified as 2A through the KSHSAA, and the JR/SR High competes in their respective Northeast Kansas League. The district receives its special education services from Keystone Learning Services in Ozawkie, Kansas.

Due to our proximity to Lawrence, Topeka, and Kansas City, a diverse population of families send their children to USD 341. Families that have been in Jefferson County for generations are mingled with families that have moved into the county from neighboring cities. Many residents commute out of the county to work.
