DISTRICT HIGHLIGHTS:

Elkhart Elementary (EES) is a school that accommodates students from 3 years old in Pre-K to 5th grade, with a current enrollment of 190 students. The school employs a Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS) and utilizes FastBridge data to tailor interventions and provide tiered instruction, aided by Title 1 personnel. Notably, the school experienced a significant improvement in KAP scores in the spring of 2023, indicating substantial progress toward pre-COVID academic levels. Additionally, EES recently expanded to include 5th grade, initiating a Builders Club to foster leadership and community involvement, which now boasts over 20 student participants.

The Middle School emphasizes student leadership through its Student Council and fosters financial literacy by collaborating with a community bank for a specialized course. Students are also given the opportunity to attend chamber luncheons, enhancing their exposure to real-world experiences. Additionally, Family and Consumer Sciences (FACS) students are recognized for their business presentations through the YEC program.

At the High School level, dedicated faculty and staff provide a supportive environment for students. The school offers Dual Credit Classes, enabling students to earn college credits while still in high school. Noteworthy facilities include an FFA Farm and an outstanding Media Center, complemented by progressive technology integration. The school is accredited by KESA and offers a range of support services including counseling, intervention teams, and integrated services. A variety of extracurricular activities and clubs cater to diverse interests, spanning from sports such as cross country, football, and volleyball, to academic pursuits like Scholar's Bowls and theatrical productions. The school also offers numerous Career and Technical Education (CTE) courses to prepare students for future career pathways.
